**Effective Jan. 1, 2016, most Augusta residents will pay \$6.40 per month for Stormwater services.** Single-family residences with more than 4,400 square feet of hard or "impervious" surface will pay \$12.80 a month. The rate for all other properties is based on total impervious surface.

Augusta's aging stormwater system is in dire need of maintenance and improvement. Stormwater runoff affects water quality and may cause flooding and erosion. It is a serious issue that the federal government is requiring all communities to address.
