
IN RE: GRAND JURY PRESENTMENT FOR THE MARCH TERM 2021







Sub-Committees were not formed due to the Coronavirus Pandemic



Inspection of Charles B Webster Detention Center

by Grand Jury Sub-Committee Conducted March 31, 2021

Inspection was conducted by six members of the Grand Jury. The center was found to be extremely clean; and while disagreeable odors were expected, there was an absence of negative odors. We observed a trustee cleaning the floor and areas we inspected. The floors are well maintained. Every area of the center appeared clean, well-organized and clutter free.

We were invited to eat lunch at the center. The meal was quite good and well prepared. The kitchen area was organized, clean and well maintained and the staff was very polite.

The intake process was thoroughly explained while we toured the area. The medical area was clean, well-stocked and staffed. The staff was attentive, pleasant, answering all questions presented to them.

The inmates appeared clean and well taken care of. The inmate's communal area and dorms were clean and monitored. The surveillance station was clutter free, offering an unrestricted view of the inmate's area. Security protocols were always followed.

Visitation area was clean and provided booths for video visitation.

Grand Jury Recommendations:

The entire jail needs to have the same surveillance system that the newer section of the jail currently has. The old system is antiquated and obsolete. To give you an idea, it is like comparing graphics of a 1977 Atari to today's Playstation 5 gaming system, or the old television that you had growing up (without remotes) to the high-definition television today. We recommend the system be updated as soon as possible.
