

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Electrical – Repair – Requirements

- 1) Electrical Contractors – License Requirements.
 - 2) Unless the person in the office is on the business license, we will require a company check or company credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover). Only the individual(s) listed on the business license can pay cash, personal check or credit card.
 - 3) Permit fee is based on job cost (Material & Labor) plus inspection fees (\$17/each).
 - ❖ ***You will need a company check or company credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover) for all transactions.*** If you get the license & permit on the same day, we can combine fees for one check. We do not require the original copies of insurance, an e-mailed copy or fax is sufficient.
 - 4) **Electrical Repair** may include any of the following:
 - a) Rewire – Power is on / off
 - b) A permit is required for all Electrical, Plumbing, Gas and Mechanical projects exceeding the cost of \$500.00 unless an inspection is required. All new installation and repair work requires a permit. Minor repairs can be made to these systems without a permit - as determined by the Building Official. All permits must be obtained prior to commencement of work to avoid penalties.
 - 5) Burglar Alarm – Wireless Systems or Cord and Plug Systems – do not require a permit.
 - 6) Building and Electrical permits for interior work may require smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms to be brought up to current code requirements.
- **** Per an agreement with Georgia Power and our office, we no longer do simple Reconnection inspections. If the building has been vacant for a long period of time and there has been NO electrical work done on the building, we do NOT require a permit / inspection. ******
