

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Electrical – Service Change / Repair (Power Cut) – Requirements

- 1) Electrical Contractors – License Requirements.
 - 2) Unless the person in the office is on the business license, we will require a company check or company credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover). Only the individual(s) listed on the business license can pay cash, personal check or credit card.
 - 3) Permit fee is based on job cost (Material & Labor) plus one inspection of \$17.
 - ❖ ***You will need a company check or company credit card (Visa, MasterCard, or Discover) for all transactions.*** If you get the license & permit on the same day, we can combine fees for one check. We do not require the original copies of insurance, an e-mailed copy or fax is sufficient.
 - 4) The power is cut or turned off and the power company will not release without our inspection. **
 - 5) **Service Change** is defined as changing ALL of the following before power can be restored:
 - a) Service panel *
 - b) Service entrance cable *
 - c) Riser
 - d) Voltage / Amperes
 - e) Meter Base
 - f) Disconnect
 - 6) Service Repair is defined as doing **one or more** (but not all) of the following:
 - a) Service panel *
 - b) Service entrance cable *
 - c) Riser
 - d) Voltage / Amperes
 - e) Meter Base
 - f) Disconnect
 - 7) After the work is complete, call our office (706-312-5050) to schedule inspection.
 - 8) Once the inspection is complete, we will release the power to the applicable company.
 - 9) You will need to coordinate the reconnection with your power company.
- * Require smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms to be brought up to current code requirements.
 - ❖ As well as any electrical work on interior requiring a permit.
- ** Per an agreement with Georgia Power and our office, we no longer do simple Reconnection inspections. If the building has been vacant for a long period of time and there has been NO electrical work done on the building, we do NOT require a permit / inspection. **
