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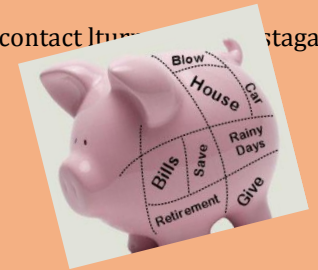
All workshops will be held from 11:30 am—1 pm in the Linda Beazley Room in the Municipal Building 535 Telfair St. Lunch will be provided.

**Workshops will cover information such as:**

- Understanding the mortgage loan process. Learn about the different types of loans that are available, the meaning of federal and state disclosures and what to do if your loan is denied. We will also explore grants and programs that are available.
- Loan repayment options and terms. Learn the ins and outs of default (avoiding and remedying) on student loan debt.
