



NOTICE TO REVIEW AND COMMENT

ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE FY 2017-2022 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

The public is invited to review and comment during a twenty-one (21) Day review period from October 23 through November 12, 2020, on amendments to the FY 2017 - 2022 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) as shown below. The Augusta Regional Transportation Study (ARTS) planning area covers the urbanized portions of Richmond and Columbia Counties, GA and Aiken and Edgefield Counties, SC. The TIP includes federally-financed transportation projects, such as road, bridge, public transit, bicycle and pedestrian improvements, scheduled to be implemented over the next four to six years in the ARTS planning area.
