Crystal has been instrumental in assisting with the implementation of CNET (Chronic Nuisance Enforcement Team), which works to improve

blighted and decaying properties in neighborhoods deemed areas of concern. CNET is a team overseen by the Marshal's Office that involves the collaboration of public and private partners. Crystal has put together a group of stakeholders concerned about blight in Augusta-Richmond County and has pledged to be part of the solution. Additionally, Crystal recently assisted with a community resource program that focuses on the interrelations between our deputies and the homeless. The program is geared towards making a positive impact during street-level encounters with the homeless. The deputies are provided with a resource bag containing daily living essentials and an updated resource guide to give the individual with necessary resources to get them the help they need. Crystal coordinated with employees from different departments and community partners, requesting donations of goods for these bags, which provided enough supplies to fill over one hundred resource bags.

Currently, Crystal is enrolled in the Basic Law Enforcement Training Academy to become a certified peace officer. Upon completing the academy, Crystal will assume a new role with the Marshal's Office as an Enforcement Officer, allowing her to advance in her career and continue the great work she has already started.

Crystal is a highly valued employee who has shown through her efforts that she supports the vision of Marshal Lamkin to provide the citizens of Augusta-Richmond County with a Clean and Safe community.
