City of Augusta to host COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics on Aug. 11 and Aug. 12

AUGUSTA, GA (Aug. 5, 2021) –The City of Augusta will host two COVID-19 vaccination clinics next week in an effort to increase the number of people vaccinated in the local area.

The City will hold a Richmond County COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday, Aug. 11, in the Linda W. Beazley Community Room, the Augusta Municipal Building.

Augusta Transit will also host a Richmond County Health Department Mobile COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic on Thursday, Aug. 12, at the Broad Street Transfer Center, located at 1546 Broad St. The clinic will be open from 6 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

At both events, the Moderna vaccine will be available for individuals 18 years old and older and the Pfizer vaccine for individuals 12 years old and older. Second dose shots of Moderna and Pfizer vaccines will also be available to those who bring vaccination cards. No appointment needed, and a nurse will be available to answer questions about COVID-19 vaccines.
