(Sept. 7, 2021) – To increase the number of vaccinated individuals in Richmond County, the City of Augusta has partnered with the Richmond County Health Department to host a citywide vaccination clinic to officially launch the City's Covid-19 Vaccination Incentive Program. Walk-ins are welcome, but individuals are encouraged to schedule an appointment at ecphd.com/schedule-online if they desire faster service.
