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City of Augusta's vaccination, food box totals from second citywide COVID-19 drive-thru vaccination clinic at Augusta Mall

AUGUSTA, GA (Nov. 20, 2021) – The City of Augusta held its second COVID-19 drive-thru mass vaccination clinic today at the Augusta Mall. First and second doses as well as booster shots were provided at this event. Additionally, Richmond County residents who received their first or second shot qualified for the City's \$100 incentive.

As part of today's clinic, the City partnered with the Golden Harvest Food Bank to distribute free food boxes on site to Richmond County residents. Individuals did not have to receive a vaccination to receive a food box.
