City of Augusta to open overnight warming center at May Park Community Center

AUGUSTA, GA (Jan. 14, 2022) – In anticipation of frigid temperatures this weekend, the City of Augusta has designated May Park Community Center as an overnight warming center. The Center is located at 622 4th St., and will be open during the following hours:

- Saturday, Jan. 15, from 5 p.m. until 9 a.m. on Sunday, Jan. 16.
- Sunday, Jan. 16, from 5 p.m. until 9 a.m. on Monday, Jan. 17.
- Monday, Jan. 17, from 5 p.m. until 9 a.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 18.

Each night, residents must be inside the facility by 9pm, and registration will be held between 5-9 p.m. Residents must bring valid identification, masks are required, and no weapons are allowed.
