Augusta, Georgia Housing and Community Development: On My Block Tour - Included in registration cost

Take a trip around our Golden Blocks! The City of Augusta, through a 2008 bond approval, cemented its commitment to revitalizing two Historic Districts in the Laney Walker and Bethlehem neighborhoods, formerly known as the Golden Blocks. Preservation efforts are ongoing through restoration of historic landmarks and new construction that acknowledges the legacies of those whose impact is still present in the community. The tour will include a 100-year-old residential restoration and over 50 newly constructed units of affordable and workforce housing.

Additionally, participants will see the location of a façade improvement project that encompasses the start of a historic commercial restoration and the 221-unit development that has sparked a downtown living resurgence in Augusta!

Lastly, as part of placemaking efforts, participants will experience public art projects throughout the tour that connect the past with the present and propel the legacy of the Golden Blocks into the future. All of this and more sits on 1,100 acres that are the focus of a targeted community development effort involving the public-private partnerships and private investment necessary to fuel future sustainability.
