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1 Introduction

The Annual List of Obligated Projects report provides documentation of all federal projects obligated in the previous Federal Fiscal Year. State and local projects are also included to provide a cooperative and comprehensive list of all projects in the Augusta Regional Transportation Study (ARTS) planning area.

The Annual List of Obligated Projects is part of federal requirements in the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century (MAP-21) signed into law July 6, 2012. Section 1201 of MAP-21 states Metropolitan Planning Organizations should produce:

“An annual listing of projects, including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities, for which Federal funds have been obligated in the preceding year shall be published or otherwise made available by the cooperative effort of the State, transit operator, and metropolitan planning organization for public review. The listing shall be consistent with the funding categories identified in the transportation improvement program (TIP)” [23 USC Section 1201].

The purpose of the listing is to increase the transparency of government spending on transportation projects and strategies in metropolitan areas to State and local officials and to the public.

An obligation is the Federal government’s legal commitment to pay the Federal share of a project’s cost. Projects for which funds have been obligated are not necessarily initiated or completed in the program year, and the amount of the obligation will not necessarily equal the total cost of the project. For Federal Transit Administration (FTA) projects, obligation occurs when the FTA grant is awarded. For Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) projects, obligation occurs when a project agreement is executed and the State or grantee requests that the funds be obligated.
