Augusta, Georgia to open overnight warming center at May Park Community Center

AUGUSTA, GA (November 18, 2022) – In the anticipation of frigid temperatures this weekend, Augusta, Georgia has designated May Park Community Center as an overnight warming center. The Center is located at 622 4th St., and will be open during the following time:

- Sunday, November 20, 2022, from 6p.m. until 9 a.m. on Monday, November 21, 2022.

Residents must be inside the facility by 9pm Sunday night, and registration will be held between 5-9 p.m. Residents must bring valid identification, masks are required, and no weapons are allowed.
