Augusta, Georgia offices to close for Good Friday

AUGUSTA, GA (April 6, 2023) – In observance of Good Friday, many of Augusta, Georgia offices will be closed Friday, April 7, 2023. Below is a list of operating hours for key services:

Augusta Municipal Building: The Augusta Municipal Building will be closed Friday, April 7. The facility will reopen on Monday, April 10, 2023, during normal business hours.

Augusta 311: The Augusta 311 Center will be open from 8:30am to 5pm on April 7.

Augusta Transit: Fixed routes, demand response and rural transit services operated by Augusta Transit and Richmond Transit will have normal hours of operation on April 7.

Augusta Utilities: All Augusta Utilities offices, including both Customer Service locations, will be closed April 7. Offices will resume normal operating hours on Monday, April 10. If there is an emergency not related to billing, call 706-842-3060.

Parks and Recreation: The administrative office, all community centers, the Augusta Aquatic Center, the Newman Tennis Center, athletic offices and the rental offices will be closed on April 7, 2023. All public parks and cemeteries remain open from dawn to dusk. Community Centers, the Augusta Aquatic Center and Newman Tennis Center will return to normal operating hours on Saturday, April 8. All other facilities will return to regular hours of operation on Monday, April 10.

Trash collection and landfill: Garbage collection and the Augusta Landfill will continue normal hours of operation on April 7.
