



Augusta's Master Road Naming and Addressing Project

Information Technology's GIS Division in collaboration with all government departments are implementing an industry standard road and addressing database in compliance with standards set by the National Emergency Numbering Association (NENA), NextGen9-1-1, USPS and ESRI.

Because location-aware mobile devices are changing our community and how we do business, an address location point is critical for developing solutions to support government business processes for locating people and places for Public Safety or locating recycle bins and trash carts for Solid Waste.

Integrated Agencies

Various internal and external agencies are directly impacted by roads and addresses. By providing consistent information to the following, IT-GIS is promoting the public health, safety and general welfare of the residing and visiting citizens of Augusta-Richmond County.

Master Road and Addressing Database

The Master Road and Addressing Database (**MRAD**) will be the **sole source** of approved and verified road names and addresses in Augusta Richmond County.

The **MRAD** is composed of 3 parts:

- 1) Master Road Name Table (**MRNT**)
-all approved & pending road names
-made available to public
- 2) Master Address Repository (**MAR**)
-all addresses (apartments, mobile homes, etc.)
-unique Site-ID assigned
-Lat/Long attributes
- 3) Master Road Centerline File (**MRCF**)
-verified public/private road locations



Location Purposes with a Different Approach

The IT-GIS Addressing Coordinator works with:

local post offices utility companies public safety agencies other local governments

Road Name Approvals

- ◆ Identify all public and private roads
- ◆ Names will not duplicate in wording or sound
- ◆ Names won't contain abbreviations/special characters
- ◆ Directional prefixes and suffixes must be used in accordance to Augusta baselines.
- ◆ Private driveways that share access with 2+ addressable structures will be named

New Address Assignment

- ◆ Assignment and reviewing agent
- ◆ Assigned at the time such request is made
- ◆ Assignment will be based on driveway location
- ◆ Multi-unit structures must be addressed in accordance to procedure as outlined in GISOP
- ◆ Miscellaneous structures including power poles, cell towers, mile markers will be assigned

Corrections/Changes

- ◆ Correction requests will be reviewed before approval
- ◆ Any property that has multiple road frontage will be verified to ensure correct sequencing
