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Restrictions – The Civic Group, officer, member, or volunteer of the organization **shall not**:

- a. be a retail tire dealer, used tire dealer, scrap tire generator, or otherwise in the tire business, now or in the future.
- b. receive payment or donations for tire sales, tire repair, tire removal, tire disposal, or tire transportation, now or in the future.
- c. be an approved/permitted Environmental Protective Division tire carrier or tire processor, now or in the future.

Civic Group Tire Collection Program Guidelines:

- a. Group will comply with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations and laws.
- b. All communication will only be made with the Environmental Services Department representative assigned to your group.
- c. Group will only remove tires from locations pre-approved by the assigned Environmental Services Department representative.
- d. Group will provide pictures of tires removed on or before tire disposal appointment as documentation of approved location.
- e. Tire disposal will be by appointment only with the assigned Environmental Services Department representative. Group will arrive on the appointed date at the appointed time.
- f. An ESD collection form must be completed, signed, and provided at tire disposal appointment.
- g. Payment terms are 30 days from date of ESD confirmation that all tire collection forms and removal picture documentation has been received and that payment has been ESD approved.

Non-Compliance with the above restrictions and program guidelines will result in immediate removal of applicant from the program as well as from future participation in any Environmental Services program. Non-compliant participant may also be required to pay disposal fees for the tires brought to the landfill.

The Environmental Services Department reserves the right to decline or terminate participation in the Civic Group Tire Collection Program upon written notice.
